Students in grades 2nd-3rd are typically in group A or C depending on their academic skills. Instruction in reading, spelling and writing is at a 1st to 4th grade level. Students have 3 classes each day focused on expanding reading skills, spelling skills and written expression. Students have 2 periods a day focused on the development on math skills at a 1st-4th grade level. Science classes also focus on the application of math skills and the understanding of science concepts. Social Studies and many of the reading lessons, are built around the development of character skills. STEAM classes are focused on Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math.
