Students in grades 7 & 8 are typically in Group E. However, students with advanced skills can begin taking high school level classes, Health Opportunities in Physical Education (HOPE), Leadership, Creative Photography and/or Algebra 1 . Florida Virtual is used for all high school classes offered at Rose Academy to ensure that students receive official high school credit. Students in group E are developing reading skills at a 7th-9th grade level. They have 2 classes each day focused on expanding reading skills, spelling skills and written expression. Students have 2 periods a day focused on the development on math skills at a pre-algebra or Algebra level. Students in this group should be able to demonstrate mastery of decimals, fractions, percentages and all 4 algorisms. The focus is preparing for Algebra 1. Science instruction focuses on preparing students for high school level science classes; Biology 1, Chemistry, Earth Space, Marine Science, and Physics. Finance Class teaches math skills as focused directly on budgeting and spending money. US Government, US History, Civics, World Cultures and the Cold War are part of Social Studies Classes.
