Students in High School at Rose are enrolled in a blended learning curriculum. Rose instructors teach each course using the Florida Virtual Curriculum. Students have 2 teachers for each Rose Class, their Rose teacher and the FLVS teacher. Rose Academy offers a state approved curriculum which results in a diploma from the state of Florida for all students completing all 24 credits and pass the Algebra 1 EOC and the FSA or an equivalent test.

FLVS flex program is used for grades 9-11, allowing students to complete courses by early May. The flex program can be especial helpful for students in an intense athletic program, or those wanting to focus on areas of specialty such as art or music.

Full-time FLVS is with students during their senior year, as the state requires this for a student to receive a standard diploma from the State of Florida. Students can enroll in advance placement classes or college classes during their senior year if they have the skills and the scores.

All high school students graduating from Rose Academy with a State of Florida diploma has gone to peruse their dreams.
